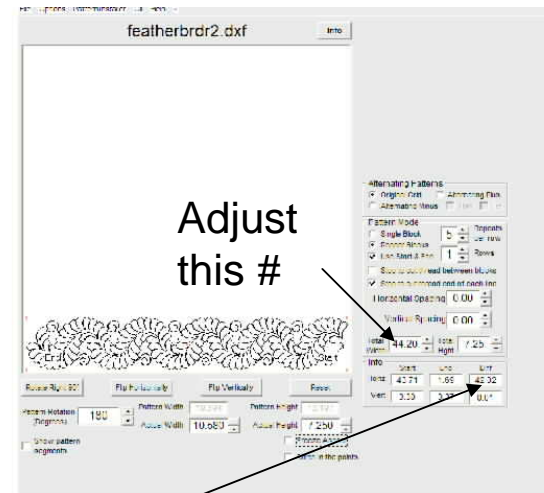
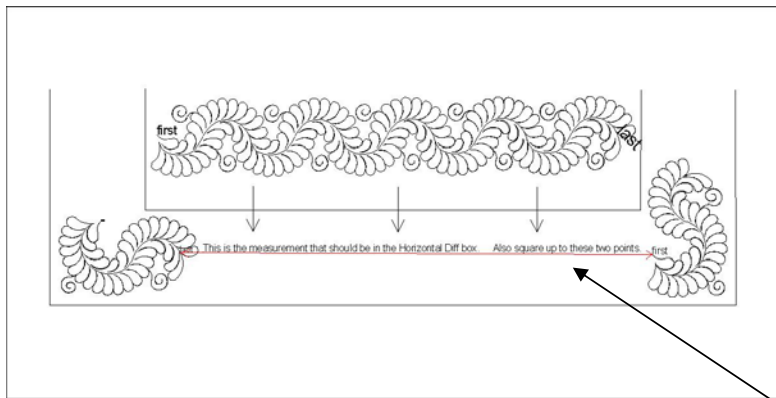


Using the Info Box to fit the border between the corners.

- Stitch your corner patterns.
- Open your border pattern and set the desired single pattern size. (Use repeat blocks mode.) Uncheck freeze aspect.
- Use the Measure option to measure from the end of the corner pattern you want to start on to the start of the corner pattern you will end on. If you start measuring where you want the pattern to start, the pattern will automatically rotate to the direction it needs to stitch. **Be sure to click the square up option.** This will eliminate the need to rotate the pattern on the screen.



This # must match this measurement

- Repeat blocks until the number in the horizontal difference box is as close as possible to your desired length.
- You will need to adjust the total width number until the horizontal difference matches your measurement.
- To test your squaring and measurements use start at pattern ending point to see if your machine goes to the correct starting point.
- If it does, remove one repeat, start at pattern starting point and stitch the pattern.
- Measure and square up the last segment and stitch. Slow the machine speed down to manipulate if necessary.
- You can stitch the side borders in segments in the same manner by using measurements of the quilt to layout the borders vertically and then reduce the number to fit your available quilting space, or you can turn the quilt.
