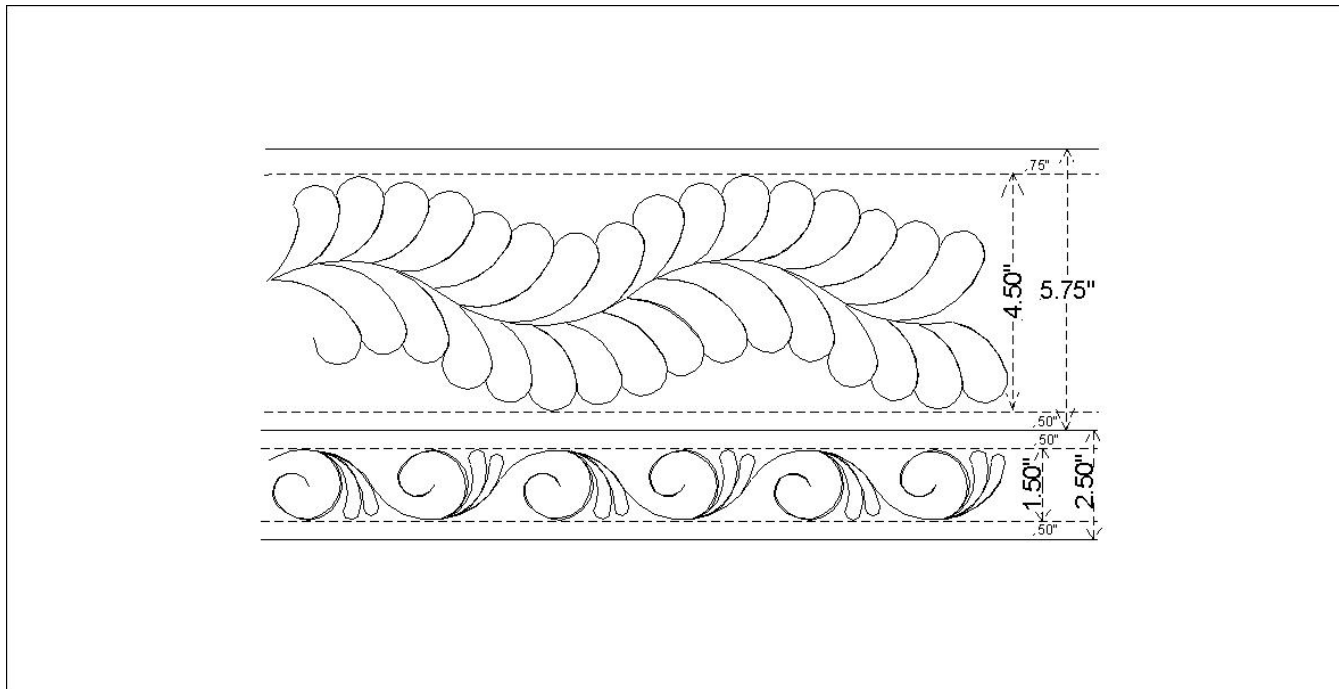


Determining border size

- When determining your border pattern size you need to consider the actual fabric border size and the margin you will need on either side of the pattern. For example: Your border measures 5.75". Subtract .75" for the outer margin, (which includes .50" for margin and .25" for binding.) Then subtract .50" for inner margin. $5.75" - 1.25" = 4.50"$ Your border height should be set to 4.50". (Don't forget to freeze aspect when making the initial size change and then turn it off to make final adjustments.) When determining sash height, you would use the same margin on either side. 2.50" sash minus 1" (for two .50" margins) equals 1.50" for the sash pattern height.
